MAERSK DRILLING ACROSS THE WORLD

We are one of the leading drilling contractors in the North Sea. In the challenging conditions met here our experience has been put to good use in a number of demanding projects, and we are highly experienced in high-pressure/high-temperature drilling as well as in technical limit drilling.

But our presence extends far beyond the waters of the North Sea. We have operated 350 and 375 ft jack-up drilling rigs for over 35 years in areas such as the Middle East, Southeast Asia, Australia, the Mediterranean and the Gulf of Mexico. We are also a leading drilling contractor in Venezuela, with our fleet of cantilevered drilling barges.

We have more than 20 years' experience in operating semi-submersibles. Our highly advanced deepwater development semi-submersibles are designed for operations in the Gulf of Mexico, Australia and Angola. These units are capable of drilling at water depths up to 3,000 m.

We are experienced in adapting to local conditions and have a number of independent offices world-wide. One of them, Egyptian Drilling Company (EDC), which is a joint venture between Maersk Drilling and the Egyptian General Petroleum Corporation, owns and operates a fleet of more than 55 land rigs and five jack-up rigs in the Middle East.

TRUE FLEXIBILITY WITH MAERSK FPSOs

We provide world-class solutions for field development, offering our oil company customers lease and operation of mobile oil and gas production units. Our customers benefit from reduced initial investment costs before the field produces oil or gas on a commercially viable scale.

We currently operate two purpose-built, harsh environment floating production storage and offloading vessels in the British sector of the North Sea. The units have a storage capacity of 615,000 bbls each and an up-time in the top end of the industry performance rates. The MAERSK CURLEW can produce 45,000 bbls of oil and export 110 mmscf of gas per day while the NORTH SEA PRODUCER can produce 76,000 bbls of oil and export 30 mmscf of gas per day.

In 2008 the latest addition to the fleet, MAERSK NGUJIMAYIN, commenced operations in Australia. This state-of-the-art vessel has a production capacity of 120,000 bbls of oil and 100 mmscf of gas per day.

We also operate a turret-moored LPG storage ship in Elf's Nkossa field off the coast of Congo.

Also included in the fleet is a combined drilling and production unit. The process module, placed on the world's largest and most advanced harsh environment jack-up, the MAERSK INSPIRER, is capable of producing 56,000 bbls of oil and 53 mmscf of gas per day.

At Maersk FPSOs we offer our customers a devoted and world-class performance wherever they are ■

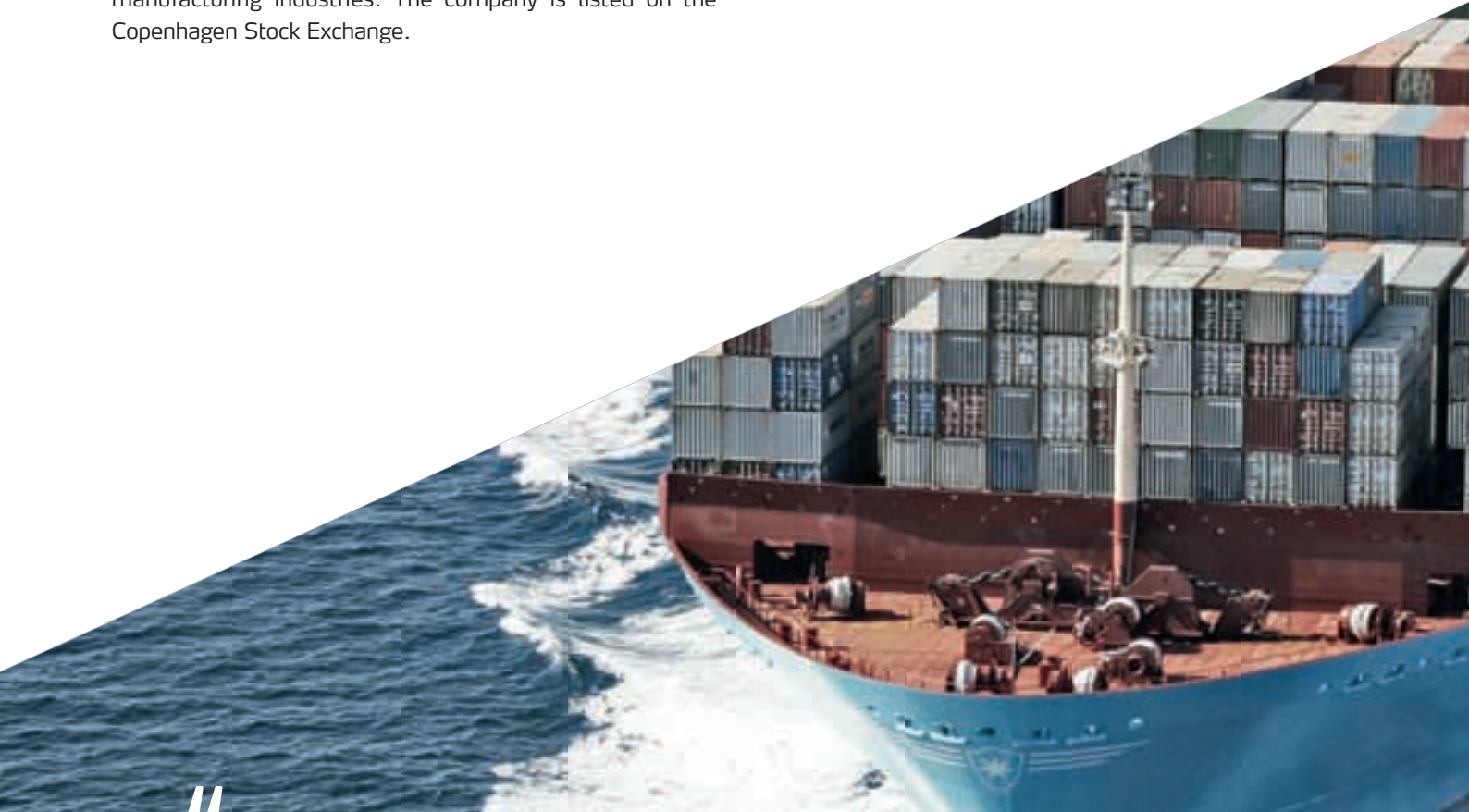
