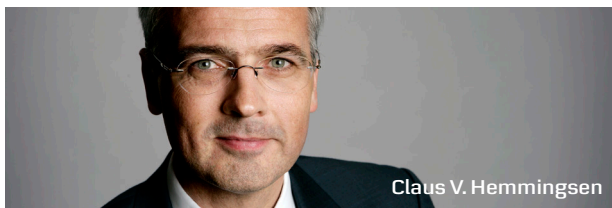
Maersk Drilling is focused on advanced engineering. Our in-house engineering department develops newbuildings and modifies

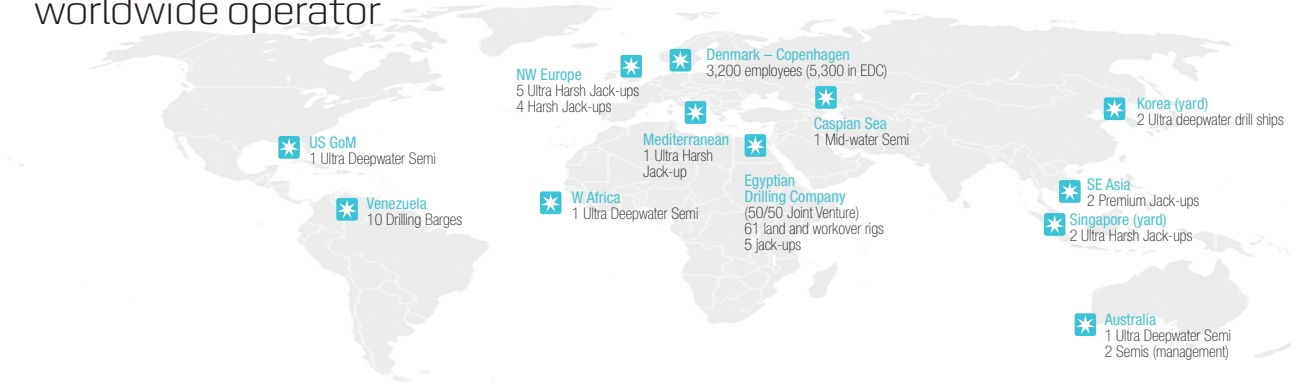

Maersk Drilling has one of the youngest and most advanced rig fleets in the industry. In the beginning of 2011 we have signed contracts for the delivery of two highly advanced new building harsh environment jack-up rigs for delivery in 2013 and 2014 respectively, and for two ultra deepwater drillships for delivery in 2013.

Activities

Maersk Drilling has operated jack-up rigs for close to 40 years including 375 & 350 ft jack-ups in areas such as the North Sea, Southeast Asia, Australia, the Mediterranean, the Middle East and the Gulf of Mexico.

We are also experienced in operating semi-submersibles and our highly advanced deepwater development semi-submersibles are capable of operating at water depths up to 3,000 m. Our deepwater semi-submersibles offer both flexibility and efficiency to our customers.

Other activities include drilling barges, rigs operated on management contracts and a joint venture with Egyptian Drilling Company, which owns and operates a fleet of more than 61 land rigs and 5 jack-up rigs in the Middle East.
